


# **Back-to-Back Mull Assemblies**


## **DEDICATED BACK-TO-BACK MULL ASSEMBLIES:**




Back-to-Back Mulls consist of two haunched jambs and a modified U-Shaped Cover.



**b.** For the U-Shaped Cover to fit properly, cut down the legs. If you are installing the U-Shaped Cover into two dedicated jambs, you will need to cut the legs down 15/16".



**a.** Cut down the core of each jamb to be 3/16" less than the overall width of the final mull, to accomodate the thickness of the U-Shaped Cover.



**c.** Hold the two cores together and fasten the cores together using one of the two options described on the right.

### **FASTENING THE TWO JAMBS TOGETHER:**


**FOR BOTH OPTIONS:** \*On the sidelite side of the Back-to-Back Mull, install screws through the jamb at the same increments, about 1" off the stop.

### **OPTION 1: Stitching Gun**

- Recommended: 1" Size Stitches
- For Jambs 6/8 or 7/0 in length, use 4-5 stitches
- For Jambs 8/0 in length, use 6-7 stitches


#### **OPTION 2: No Stitching Gun, Using Screws**

- Recommended: #6 x 1" or #8 x 1" Screws
- Insert screws through the active side adjacent to the jamb stop, tucked under the weatherstrip.
- For Jambs 6/8 or 7/0 in length, use 4-5 screws on each side
- For Jambs 8/0 in length, use 6-7 screws on each side


## **DEDICATED BACK-TO-BACK MULL ASSEMBLIES (CONT.):**



**d.** Install the modified U-Shaped Cover into the brickmould slots to cover the exposed cores.

When using an Extra Deep U-Shaped Cover, chamfer the edges of the core


### STORM DOOR READY BACK-TO-BACK MULL ASSEMBLIES:




Back-to-Back

### THINGS TO CONSIDER:

- If you are removing less than 1/2" from a Rippable Jamb, you will need to use the Extra Deep 1.5" U-Shaped Cover.
- Screws can be fastened through the exposed core before the U-Shaped Cover is installed to maintain prefinished look.
- The U-Shaped Covers are 3/16" thick, meaning you will have to cut down the core to be 3/16" less of your desired mull width.




**a.** Cut down the core of each jamb to be 3/16" less than the overall width of the final mull.




**b.** For the U-Shaped Cover to fit properly, cut down the legs an equal distance to what was removed from the core.

# STORM DOOR READY BACK-TO-BACK MULL ASSEMBLIES (CONT.):




**c.** Hold the two jambs back-to-back and Install screws through the exposed core of the jambs.



**d.** On the side of the sidelite panel, install screws through the jamb, about 1" off the jamb stop and along the length of the jamb.

- Recommended: #6 x 1" or #8 x 1" Screws
- For Jambs 6/8 or 7/0 in length, use 4-5 screws on each side
- For Jambs 8/0 in length, use 6-7 screws on each side



**e.** Install the modified U-Shaped Cover into the brickmould slots to cover the exposed cores.
