



When using a one-piece mull:



When using back-to-back jambs (in an assembly built with either 4-9/16" or 6-9/16" dedicated side jambs):




When using back-to-back jambs (in an assembly built with either 6-9/16" or 8-9/16" width-adjustable side jambs):




WHAT COMPONENTS SHOULD BE USED FOR A CONTINUOUS SIDELITE SYSTEM WITHOUT A STORM DOOR?




WHAT COMPONENTS SHOULD BE USED TO CREATE A SPREAD MULL?
